MENTORING is...

- A relationship with primary end goal of maturity in Christ
- Intentional
- Making disciples of Jesus, not ourselves
- Takes place in one on one or one on two relationship
- A process whereby the leader wants to help the follower become all that the follower can be – "follower-centric"
- Its nature is not production, but reproduction - we disciple another and then that person goes and teaches others

MENTORING is not a teacher/student relationship or counseling.
